Scouting for the tastiest moderate to high-end cabernet and Bordeaux red blends

Wine writer Peg Melnik had a blind tasting this week of cabernet sauvignons and Bordeaux red blends, from juicy and approachable, to lean and austere. While there were many impressive wines in the flight, our wine-of-the-week winner is the Pedroncelli, 2009 Block 007, Dry Creek Valley Cabernet Sauvignon because it's a steal - a tasty, solid cab at \$25.
