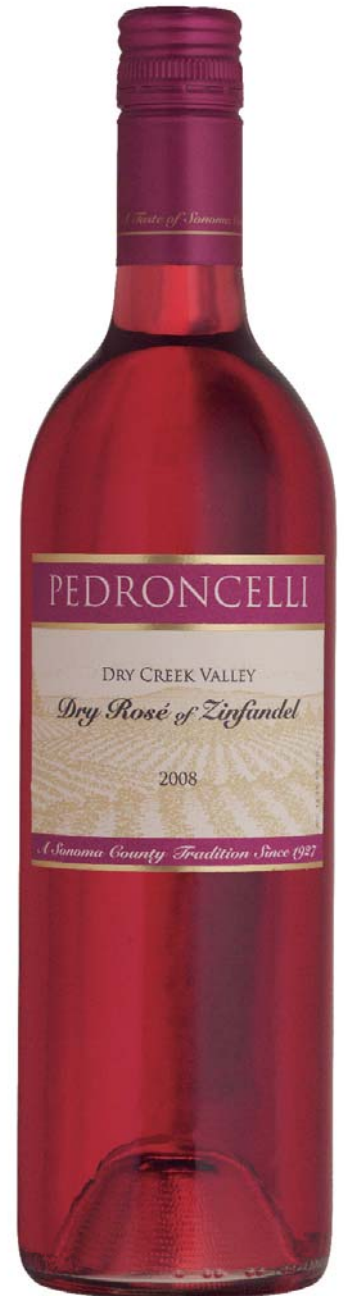

2008 Dry Rosé of Zinfandel
Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County

History and Vineyard Sources

In the early 1950's, John Pedroncelli created a rosé originally from a blend of grapes and called it Vin Rose. In 1954, he created our Zinfandel Rosé and we have had one every year since. Grapes for our Dry Rosé of Zinfandel were harvested from the Pedroncelli estate vineyards along with fruit from the Bushnell Vineyard, a long-standing source of Zinfandel for us. The area's well-drained rocky soils, hillsides, and excellent microclimate enable Zinfandel to develop generous fruit flavors. Because the grapes were picked at full maturity the last week of August, the natural varietal fruit flavor and color are evident in the finished wine.
